CONSTITUTION OF BRUNEI DARUSSALAM
{Order under section 83(3)}

EMERGENCY (PENAL CODE) (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1999

In exercise of the power conferred by subsection (3) of section 83 of the Constitution of Brunei Darussalam, His Majesty the Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan hereby makes the following Order –

1. This Order may be cited as the Emergency (Penal Code) (Amendment) Order, 1999. Citation.

2. The Penal Code is amended by inserting the following new section immediately after section 294 – Insertion of new section 294A into Chapter 22.

"Loitering or soliciting for purpose of prostitution etc.	294A. Whoever loiters or solicits in any place for the purpose of prostitution or for any other immoral purpose shall be guilty of an offence and shall be punished with a fine of not less than \$500 and not more than \$5,000 and imprisonment which may extend to one year, and in the case of a second or subsequent conviction, with a fine of not less than \$1,000 and not more than \$10,000 and imprisonment which may extend to 3 years."
