CONSTITUTION OF BRUNEI DARUSSALAM
(Order under section 83(3))

EMERGENCY (ROAD TRAFFIC ACT) (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1999

In exercise of the power conferred by subsection (3) of section 83 of the Constitution of Brunei Darussalam, His Majesty the Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan hereby makes the following Order —

1. This Order may be cited as the Emergency (Road Traffic Act) (Amendment) Order, 1999. Citation.

2. The Road Traffic Act, in this Order referred to as the Act, is amended by inserting the following new section immediately after section 79 — Insertion of new section 79A into Chapter 68.

"Toll on vehicles using roads.

79A. (1) The Minister, with the approval of His Majesty the Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan, may make orders for the imposition of a toll on vehicles using any road, and any such orders shall specify the nature, amount, rate and the manner of payment of any such toll.

(2) Such orders may provide for different amounts and rates of toll for different types and categories of vehicle.

(3) The Minister may exempt any vehicle or class of vehicle from the provisions of subsection (2) on such conditions as he may impose.

(4) In this section, "toll" includes any levy, due or other charge to be paid to the Government for using the road."

3. Section 93 of the Act is amended, in subsection (2), by inserting the following new paragraph immediately after paragraph (33) — Amendment of section 93.

"(33A) the removal from roads, detention and immobilisation, of stationary vehicles (including any load carried thereby) and for their subsequent disposal or forfeiture;"
