CONSTITUTION OF BRUNEI DARUSSALAM
(Order made under Articles 83(3) and (5))

SUPPLEMENTARY SUPPLY (2010/2011) (NO. 3) ORDER, 2011

WHEREAS His Majesty the Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan by a Proclamation of Emergency (S 56/09) dated the 24th. day of November, 2009 has declared and proclaimed as of that day a state of emergency in the whole of Brunei Darussalam;

AND WHEREAS it is provided by Article 83(3) of the Constitution of Brunei Darussalam that when a Proclamation of Emergency has been made and so long as such Proclamation is in force, His Majesty the Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan may make any Orders whatsoever which he considers desirable in the public interest;

AND WHEREAS it is provided by Article 83(5) of the Constitution of Brunei Darussalam that His Majesty the Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan may, by such Order, make all such financial provisions as he thinks necessary during the period of the emergency, including provision for the public service;

AND WHEREAS the sum of four thousand, nine hundred and eighty-five million, seven hundred and eighty-five thousand and six hundred dollars (\$4,985,785,600.00) has been provided by the Supply (2010/2011) Act, 2010 (Act 1 of 2010);

AND WHEREAS the sum of sixteen million, three hundred and sixty-three thousand dollars (\$16,363,000.00) has been provided by the Supplementary Supply (2010/2011) (No. 1) Order, 2011 (S 4/11);

AND WHEREAS the sum of twenty-four million, three hundred and eighteen thousand, eight hundred and ninety-eight dollars and fourteen cents (\$24,318,898.14) has been provided by the Supplementary Supply (2010/2011) (No. 2) Order, 2011;

AND WHEREAS it is now requisite to make a further provision of twelve million, seven hundred and twenty-six thousand, seven hundred and eighty-three dollars and forty-six cents (\$12,726,783.46);

NOW, THEREFORE, in the exercise of the powers conferred on him by Articles 83(3) and (5) of the Constitution of Brunei Darussalam, His Majesty the Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan hereby makes the following Order —

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as the Supplementary Supply (2010/2011) (No. 3) Order, 2011.

Further expenditure for the year 2010/2011, appropriation and replacement of amount advanced from Contingencies Fund.

2. (1) The issue of a sum not exceeding twelve million, seven hundred and twenty-six thousand, seven hundred and eighty-three dollars and forty-six cents (\$12,726,783.46) out of the Consolidated Fund for expenditure on the services specified in the Schedule for the year 2010/2011, not provided or not fully provided for by the Supply (2010/2011) Act, 2010 (Act 1 of 2010), Supplementary Supply (2010/2011) (No. 1) Order, 2011 (S 4/11) and Supplementary Supply (2010/2011) (No. 2) Order, 2011 is hereby authorised.

(2) Such sum is appropriated for the purposes specified in the Schedule.

(3) The replacement out of the amount shown in the third column of the amount shown in the fourth column of the Schedule bearing the amount advanced from the Contingencies Fund created by section 10(1) of the Constitution (Financial Procedure) Order is hereby authorised.
