LEGAL PROFESSION (ALTERNATIVE QUALIFICATION) RULES, 1999

In exercise of the powers conferred by sections 3(2) and 65(2)(b) of the Legal Profession Act, the Chief Justice, with the approval of His Majesty the Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan, hereby makes the following Rules —

Citation and commencement. 1. These Rules may be cited as the Legal Profession (Alternative Qualification) Rules, 1999 and shall commence on the same day as the Emergency (Legal Profession Act) (Amendment) Order, 1999.

Alternative qualification. 2. The following qualifications are hereby prescribed as alternative qualifications for the purposes of subsection (2) of section 3 —

(a) the Certificate of Legal Practice issued by the Qualifying Board pursuant to section 5 of the Legal Profession Act, 1976 of Malaysia;

(b) degree in law conferred by the Universiti Islam Antarabangsa of Malaysia.
