CONSTITUTION OF BRUNEI DARUSSALAM
(Order under Article 83(3) and (5))

SUPPLEMENTARY SUPPLY (2005/2006) (NO. 5) ORDER, 2005

WHEREAS His Majesty the Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan by a Proclamation of Emergency (S 22/04) dated the 8th. day of March, 2004 has declared and proclaimed as of that day a state of emergency in the whole State;

AND WHEREAS it is provided by Clause (3) of Article 83 of the Constitution of Brunei Darussalam that when a Proclamation of Emergency has been made and so long as such Proclamation is in force, His Majesty the Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan may make any Orders whatsoever which he considers desirable in the public interest;

AND WHEREAS it is provided by Clause (5) of Article 83 of the Constitution of Brunei Darussalam that His Majesty the Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan may make all such financial provisions as he thinks necessary during the period of the emergency, including provision for the public service;

AND WHEREAS the sum of four thousand, four hundred and thirty-three million, eight hundred and fifty-two thousand, four hundred and six dollars (\$4,433,852,406.00) has been provided by the Supply (2005/2006) Order, 2005 (S 22/05);

AND WHEREAS the sum of thirty-one million, seven hundred and seven thousand, four hundred and ninety-nine dollars (\$31,707,499.00) has been provided by the Supplementary Supply (2005/2006) (No. 1) Order, 2005 (S 58/05);

AND WHEREAS the sum of twenty-eight million, nine hundred and thirty-four thousand, three hundred and fifty-one dollars and four cents (\$28,934,351.04) has been provided by the Supplementary Supply (2005/2006) (No. 2) Order, 2005 (S 62/05);

AND WHEREAS the sum of twenty-seven million dollars (\$27,000,000.00) has been provided by the Supplementary Supply (2005/2006) (No. 3) Order, 2005 (S 63/05);

AND WHEREAS the sum of twenty-nine million, three thousand and five hundred dollars (\$29,003,500.00) has been provided by the Supplementary Supply (2005/2006) (No. 4) Order, 2005 (S 73/05);

AND WHEREAS it is now requisite to make a further provision of twenty-nine million, four hundred and eighty thousand, fifty-three dollars and six cents (\$29,480,053.06);

**PASSPORTS ACT
(CHAPTER 146)**

PASSPORTS (VISA) (EXEMPTION) (AMENDMENT) (NO. 4) ORDER, 2005

In exercise of the power conferred by section 4 of the Passports Act, His Majesty the Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan hereby makes the following Order —

Citation and commencement.

1. This Order may be cited as the Passports (Visa) (Exemption) (Amendment) (No. 4) Order, 2005 and shall commence on the day it is made.

Amendment of Third Schedule to S 2/85.

2. The Passports (Visa) (Exemption) Order, 1985 is amended, in the Third Schedule, by adding "REPUBLIC OF SLOVENIA".
